## *Advanced cardiac care close to home*

CTMC began its cardiac service expansion in 2011 when the hospital achieved designation as an Accredited Chest Pain Center by the Society of Chest Pain Centers. The accreditation enhances CTMC's ability to receive, assess, diagnose and treat patients suffering from chest pain or other potential heart attack symptoms by immediately following specific protocols and procedures.

In 2012, CTMC introduced its first cardiac catheterization lab with the capability to intervene during a cardiac event. Today, CTMC operates two interventional cardiac catheterization labs and, through a partnership with Austin Heart, has two full-time interventional cardiologists on staff. After rigorous review, The Joint Commission and the American Heart/Stroke Association recognized CTMC with Advanced Certification for Primary Stroke Centers.

The CTMC Cardiac Rehabilitation Program was implemented in 2014 to assist patients with returning to a normal life after suffering a cardiac event. In 2015, Bruce and Gloria Ingram donated a generous \$1.1 million gift to expand CTMC's cardiac services and establish the Ingram Heart Center at CTMC.

The most recent advancements to CTMC's cardiac program include the addition of laser artherectomy equipment, which treats blocked arteries in the heart using a laser. Additionally, CTMC recently became the only hospital along the IH-35 corridor between Austin and San Antonio to offer the EKOS® Acoustic Pulse Thrombolysis™ procedure, a life-saving technique that dissolves blood clots in the vascular system via a catheter.


